

On-Campus Accommodation Information & FAQ

What type of residence halls are available?

This year, we will offer air-conditioned, apartment-style residence halls! Each apartment will have a combination of double and single rooms as well as shared common areas (bathroom, living area, etc.)

What is a single room and a double room?

A single room is a bedroom with one Twin XL bed. A double room is a bedroom with TWO Twin XL beds.

Will I have to share a bathroom?

There will be a shared bathroom and living space in each apartment. However, the bedrooms are private. Only you (and your roommate, if applicable) will have access to it.

Is there a chance I will be put in an apartment or room with someone I don't know? Maybe. There are a limited number of beds and apartments. While we will do our best to accommodate everyone and their requests, we just cannot guarantee.

How much does it cost to stay in a residence hall for Alumni Weekend?

Single Room - \$99 Per Person, for the weekend.

Double Room - \$75 Per Person, for the weekend. When you book a double room, you must register for two people.

What is included in the price?

Two nights in an on-campus residence hall, and a basic linen set.

What is a basic linen set?

A basic linen set includes two sheets, one pillow and pillowcase, one blanket, two towels, and a washcloth.

What should I bring?

Any personal care items or things that are not listed above. And if you need extra blankets, towels, etc, we suggest bringing those along.





May I request a roommate?

Of course! When you register, you can request a roommate. Please make sure that both you and your requested roommate have each other listed.

If you have a group of people who wish to stay in the same apartment, everyone has to list each other under roommate requests. ** We will do our very best to accommodate roommate requests, but we cannot guarantee it**.



How many people can stay in my residence hall bedroom?

The number of people occupying each room cannot exceed the number of beds. For example, if you book a single room, only one person can occupy the room.



Are children allowed to stay overnight?

Unfortunately, nobody under the age of 18 can stay in our residence halls over Alumni Weekend.



Where can I pick up my keys?

You will get your keys when you check in with our team in Ensor Lounge.

Saturday, June 1 - 9 a.m. - 6:30 p.m.

If you need to check in outside of these hours, please contact the Office of Alumni Engagement.



What time is check-out?

All rooms must be vacated, and room keys returned to the Alumni Engagement Team by 11 a.m. on Sunday, June 2. Check-out will be in the Roj Student Center across from the bookstore!



Do I have to pre-register for on-campus accommodations?

Yes! You must register by May 17 for on-campus housing, or until all rooms are reserved. We will not be able to accommodate requests on-site during Alumni Weekend 2024.
