*Since this is only a 2-day, 1-night program, we encourage you to travel light! We anticipate that you will only need 1 or 2 packed bags for this program.

PACKING SUGGESTIONS

- Overnight bag
- Casual, comfortable attire with at least 3 changes of clothes; sweatshirt/jacket; sleepwear; **comfortable shoes for walking**; flip flops/shower shoes

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POLICIES & EXPECTATIONS
